

Ideas for getting to Endicott Gardens Bed & Breakfast & Spa on the beautiful Southern Coast of Oregon!

The Airports are listed by distance (shortest to longest) below as it relates to the drive time from the airport to Gold Beach. Depending on the amount of time you have, there are many beautiful journeys you can take to get here to fit your lifestyle! Make it a beautiful journey as you come visit us at Endicott Gardens Bed & Breakfast and Spa!

1. Crescent City, California /Del Norte County Regional Airport (CEC) (1 hour - 55 miles) :

This airport is located South of Gold Beach and the shortest drive time. You fly from your home town to Oakland California on any airline you choose. Then you would take a short flight from Oakland, CA to Crescent City California via Advanced Airlines (www.advancedairlines.com). If booked well in advance, the flights from Oakland to Crescent City can be very affordable. You may spend a little more time in the airport with changing flights and airlines, but your drive time to Gold Beach will be the shortest. It is a beautiful, scenic drive up the coast! If planned well in advance, this can be a really great option. This is a smaller airport with easy in and out. Avis and Budget offer car rentals in Crescent City.

2. Northbend / Coos Bay Oregon (OTH) Regional (1.5 hours -83 miles): This airport is located North of Gold Beach and is serviced by United Airlines year round. Some cities have direct flights in to the airport. These flights are convenient! They typically are a bit higher in cost than the other larger airports. This is a small airport with easy in and out. Car rental is available at the airport.

3. McKinleyville, California (ACV) Regional (2.25 hours - 122 miles): Our favorite route! This airport is located South and is a beautiful drive through the Redwood Forest. This airport is serviced by United Airlines. You will typically have a stop in San Francisco or Los Angeles. Car rental is available at this airport. This is a small airport with easy in & out access.

4. Medford, Oregon (MFR) Rogue Valley International Airport (3 hours - 150 miles): This International airport is located East of Gold Beach and is a very scenic and winding road drive! It is a major airport serviced by many different airlines and car rental operations. Some flights are non-stop, direct flights. This choice will typically save you time and money. Although located in a larger city, the Medford airport is fairly easy to get in and out of. When you drive from Medford to Gold Beach, you have to go around a mountain range. You will take Highway 199 which will lead you South and West and through the upper part of California and then onto the coast highway where you will travel North to Gold Beach. Medford can have snow in the winter months. Although a beautiful and scenic drive, it may not be the first choice for those that do not prefer winding, mountain roads.

5. Eugene, Oregon (EUG) Mahlon Sweet Field (3.5 hours - 185 miles): This airport is located North and East of Gold Beach and is serviced by numerous airlines and car rental operations. Many flights are direct. One of the most beautiful drives to Gold Beach as you will pass through countryside on your way to the coast and through charming little towns along the way. Eugene is a larger city, however the airport is still very easy to get in and out of. This option usually has better pricing for tickets, especially if planned well in advance.

6. Portland, Oregon (PDX) International (5.25 hours - 300 miles): This is the most cost effective way to visit, even if you are planning a last minute trip! Portland is serviced by numerous airlines, car rental operations, and many flights are direct, even from the East coast. Although the drive is longer, the options along the way are many! You can travel through Oregon's wine country, or visit many sea towns along the coast! Fares are typically reasonable and can be as low as \$150 to about \$300, making it a great cost effective option. Although you are driving longer, you won't be spending time in the airport between connecting flights! If you have not been to Oregon yet, this gives you a chance to see much of its beauty! This is a good option for those exploring more of the state on the way to Gold Beach!
